About our data

The WRPS jurisdiction is the Regional Municipality of Waterloo. The Region of Waterloo is divided into three divisions, with 28 zones in total for optimum police service delivery. The zones are designated in the following manner:

- North zones = WN1-WN8 and WR1-WR4;
- Central zones = WC1-WC8;
- South zones = WS1-WS8

These boundaries were last updated in 2016. The boundaries are based upon the NAD1983 UTM Zone 17N Transverse Mercator projection coordinate system.
